Level 2 Certificate in British Sign Language

Students will develop the communication skills acquired at Level 1. The course focuses on receptive, productive and conversational skills enabling students to participate in longer, open-ended conversations using a range of familiar and unfamiliar topics in BSL.

What is the course about?

The course consists of three units:

Receptive Skills

Students will develop these skills using narrative, referring to everyday situations & conversations in BSL.

Productive Skills

Students will demonstrate their productive skills through the use of presentations, using everyday situations & conversations.

Conversational

Students will develop & demonstrate their ability to hold a conversation using & understanding BSL. This includes the use of everyday situations about familiar & unfamiliar topics, expressing opinions & clarifying their understanding.

Will I receive a recognised qualification?

There are three short practical assessments during the course, one for each of the three units. If you successfully pass all three assessments, you will receive a nationally recognised qualification from Signature (previously known as CACDP).

Do I need any previous experience?

You will need to have successfully completed Signature's Level 1 Certificate in British Sign Language.

When does the course start & how long does the course last?

The course is 3 hours per week for 30 weeks at the Deafness Resource Centre on Thursdays from 12.00pm – 3.00pm starting on 15th April 2010.

How much does it cost?

Course fees including assessment: £408.00 per person
