Deaf=Equality Training **Deaf and Deafblind Awareness**

What is the course about?

The aim of the course is to promote positive attitudes and action towards deaf and deafblind people, in order to help reverse discrimination. The course will identify types of deafness and deaf-blindness, Deaf and deaf-blind people's preferred communication methods and how to avoid difficulties that affect deaf and deafblind people's access to communication. The course will also address the meaning of discrimination and acceptable terminology.

Who is the course aimed at?

Under the DDA (2005) employers and service providers have a duty to ensure equal access to deaf and deafblind people. This course would enable employers and staff to work toward achieving equal access.

Will I receive a recognised qualification?

There is a 20 minute written assessment at the end of the course. If you successfully pass the assessment, you will receive a certificate from Signature (previously called CACDP).

Do I need any previous experience?

Students need no previous knowledge.

When does the course start & how long does the course last?

The course is two full days. Please contact us for the next course dates. Student names are registered with Signature prior to the course, therefore the named student must attend. A place can not be delegated to a colleague.
